



Minutes of the Annual General Meeting of Kampong Hash House Harriers

Held at 4.30pm, 21 March 2026, at 936 East Coast Road

The GM called the meeting to order at 4.45pm and noted that at that stage a quorum had been reached (being seven members out of 22, more than 25% of the membership).

The Minutes of the last AGM were presented – Proposed (Graham Sofio), Seconded (Catriona Moore) and passed unanimously.

President's Report

President presented his report on the year:

- The Kampong Hash House Harriers continued in the 2025/26 year much as in the previous year, although there were no special occasions
- The President noted that numbers maintain their slow decline and, assuming we all care about the future of the Kampong Hash, everyone should look for opportunities to encourage new members – as well as inviting guests from other chapters
- Guest fees are keeping the financials in a satisfactory position, but solid memberships are important.

Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer arrived in time to present the accounts for the Hash for the year ended 31 December 2025:

- The Club generated a deficiency of \$567.75 for the year and Accumulated Funds have decreased to \$13,737.60
- General subscriptions have declined and guest fees were also down



- The club did contribute to the Seletar Hash House Harriers' 45th Anniversary because their run coincided with our Run 286 – but the contribution was not much greater than a normal run expense.
- The Club remains dependant on guest fees – but turning a profit on our 300th Run celebration in August should be a focus.

Election of New Committee

The entire Committee was put forward en bloc and approved unanimously

Election of Auditors

Catriona Moore and Margaret Santhana-Francis were proposed as Auditors for 2026 / 27 and elected unanimously.

The outgoing Auditors, Amuna Ramasamy and Linda Sim Puay Hiang, confirmed (via Amuna Ramasamy, as Linda Sim was an apology) that their review had revealed no issues with the accounts.

Any Other Business

- A) The President noted that the 300th Run of Kampong Hash will take place on 15 August 2026 and passed over to Vice-President, Graham Sofio, who is co-ordinating the planning.

Graham Sofio noted that Changi Sailing Club has been confirmed as a venue for the 300th Run, with the actual run to take place on Pulau Ubin. A sub-committee consisting of Graham Sofio, Amuna Ramasamy and Margaret Santhana-Francis has been formed. The President offered to assist if helpful and requested that the sub-committee produce a budget for the event as soon as possible.



“Save the Date” notifications are going to be provided to all other Singapore-based hash chapters as quickly as possible.

- B) The President noted that, following questions about run counts at the last AGM, work has been undertaken by Graham Sofio and Katherine Tan Bee Phang and we are close to circulating revised numbers to the club. There may well then be some catch-up to do in relation to jackets and badges. The expectation is that this will be sorted out by the April 2026 run.
- C) Work has also taken place in relation to the club’s records with the Registrar of Societies, led by Jude Tan. The resident will seek an additional report from Jude Tan before the April run.

Without any further matters, the meeting was declared closed at 5.15pm.
