Minutes of the Inaugural AGM, 15 July 2000

The meeting was called to order by Venugopal Kurup (GM of organizing committee) at 4:52 PM. The guests were excused, and the meeting proceeded with 41 members. The committee then appointed Alice Goh and Mike Smith as auditors for the coming year.

The GM then brought forth a motion in the form of Resolution 1: To open an account at a suitable local bank in the name Kampong Hash House Harriers, wherein the GM, Hash Cash and On Sec are authorized to sign cheques and any two signatures are sufficient. Ong Chye Ong seconded this motion and it was passed unanimously.

The GM proposed another motion in the form of Resolution 2: Fees shall be fixed at the following quarterly rate: Men - \$40, Women - \$20 and Insurance - \$10. Mike Smith seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

With questions from the floor entertained, Eddie Poh asked about plans for the Dinner & Dance. The GM stated that this year there would be a special run in December held on Pulau Ubin. This run will be an over night affair and will be a combination of the Dinner & Dance, Family Run and December run. The question of holding separate events for these functions will be revisited next year when we have a full year to plan.

The committee fixed the Guest Fee at Men - \$20 and Women - \$10.

There being no further business, Mike Smith proposed that the meeting be adjourned. Paul Hermolle seconded, and the meeting was closed at 5:09 PM.
